Okereke (2008) noted that, application of ICT to teaching and learning makes instructions more effective and productive. In this regard ICT is viewed as innovations that enable English Language teachers facilitate teaching and learning of English language.

English Language is an academic subject that helps students to be exposed to realities of business practices. The subject is designed to introduce students to the foundational knowledge of the principles and practices of business. Okute (2008) opined that English Language is the fundamental subject which has to do with acquisition, conservation and expedition of wealth. Osuala (2004) stated that English Language help the students to make informed decisions in the everyday business of living. Obi (2005), explained that English Language prepares students for several careers or enables those in that career become more efficient and advance to higher positions in terms of speaking and writing. These teachers are trained in different higher institutions of learning where they obtain various qualifications. In this study, a English Language teacher is someone who is trained in pedagogical areas of English Language and is charged with the responsibilities of imparting acquired knowledge, skills and attitudes of English Language to students in junior secondary schools.
