- Amma Vodi: This Major Scheme addressing the importance of education among parentsas well as students, the Amma Vodi scheme offers financial assistance of 15,000 INR to the mothers or guardians of school-going children who are eligible. This kind of financialsupport ensures that economic constraints do not hinder children's access to quality education. Without any financial burden parents can freely send their children to school.
- 2. Vidya Deevena & Vasathi Deevena: Building upon the commitment to education, these two schemes offer monetary support to students who are pursuing higher education and tothe students those who are residing in hostels. This financial assistance facilitates and ensures students' pursue their courses and develop skills without any financial constraints.
- **3. Nadu-Nedu:** The Nadu-Nedu program aims to target the transformation of Government schools by improving the all the required infrastructure, sanitation facilities, and also the overall learning environment. This initiative envisions providing the students with modernfacilities and conducive learning spaces in schools and colleges.

1. Amma Vodi: Empowering Education and Enabling Dreams of Students & Parents

Jagananna Amma Vodi scheme will benefit the students around 43 lakh households. The Second phase of the Amma Vodi scheme was launched on 11th Jan 2021 with a budget allocated amount of rupees ₹6673 crore which in turn benefiting 45 lakh people in the entire state of Andhra Pradesh. Following the three years governance, the budget covers nearly 6000 crores of rupees specifically for this scheme. Over all the total allocation of the Jagananna Amma Vodi from the academic years 2019-2024 duration will be almost 30,000 -35,000 crore rupees. The primary objective of this scheme isto encourage admissions and attendance rates in schools, especially among economically disadvantaged families. This scheme also benefits by decreasing the school drop outs, as the eligibility for the scheme is set to 75% of student's attendance. By offering the financial assistance directly to the mothers or guardians, this scheme seeks to alleviate the financial barriers that might hinder the children from accessing quality education.

Eligibility:

The mother/guardian of the children must be reside in Andhra Pradesh. The child of the mothermust attend from 1st to 12th grade.

The school of the child is admitted must be a Government Accredited School, or a Supported and registered Private

School, Jr. College or boarding school/Jr.College in Andhra Pradesh.

The program runs from the academic years 2019-2024. Total household income must be less than ₹10,000 per month for rural areas; and ₹12,000/- per month for urban areas (BPL).

No member of the child's family must be a state/central government employee or government retiree. (except for family of medical staff). The Applicant's family must not own a four- wheeled vehicle (except taxis, tractors and cabs). The monthly power consumption of the applicant's family (own /rent) must be less than 300 units (at average six months).

No member of the applicant's family must be a taxpayer to the government. The land below the municipality must be less than 1,000 square feet. School attendance of the student should be at least 75%.

Key Features and Benefits:

The Amma Vodi scheme is boasting the several distinctive features that are contributing to itssuccess are the following:

1. Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT): Under this scheme, the eligible beneficiaries will receive a fixed amount which is directly credited into their bank accounts. This will provide flexibility to utilize the funds for various educational expenses and others.
